

# YOUTH BASEBALL/SOFTBALL BAT RULES

## BOYS BASEBALL

With our change to sanction with **Baseball Players Association**, the following rules will be in place:

The bat shall not exceed more than 2 3/4 inches in diameter at the thickest part and not more than 36 inches in length.

Additionally in the JUNIOR (Ages 13-15) DIVISION:

The bat shall meet the BBCOR .50 standard, not exceed more than 2 5/8 inches in diameter at the thickest part and shall not weigh numerically more than three (3) ounces less than the length of the bat. (Example: A 33 inch bat cannot be less than 30 ounces.)

The USABat stamped bats required for play last season are still legal and may be used.

## GIRLS SOFTBALL (Fastpitch and Slowpitch)

All approved bats must have the NSA 2012 stamp.
